MCAC Reef Fund to deploy the Hailey Glasrud Reef this week

Stuart, FL – (April 22, 2014) — The MCAC Reef Fund will be deploying the Hailey Glasrud Reef this Thursday. She will be the 4th vessel to be deployed as a reef by the group in their 11 years of reefing. “The Hailey Glasrud (formerly known as D.M. One) is a 224’ ship (Bulk Carrier) with 80’ of verticality,” says John Burke, President of the MCAC Reef Fund. “She’s going to be a great addition to the Martin County Sirotkin reef site.”

Her deployment is scheduled for Thursday, April 24th, at approximately 10 AM, depending on travel and weather conditions. If you are interested in viewing the deployment in person, the destination is located 8.9 miles slightly E-NE of the St. Lucie Inlet, 27°12.563’ / 80°00.254’, in 187’ of water.
